Supplier's Declaration for articles / article parts

REACH and Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC), regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006

An article is an object, which during production is given a special shape, surface or design, which determines its function to a greater degree than its chemical composition. According to the EU REACH regulation, articles that are assembled or joined together in a complex object remain articles, as long as they live up to this definition.

Articles containing Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) on the REACH candidate list issued by ECHA (European Chemicals Agency) are subject to written information, when sold within EU. Suppliers must submit a Supplier's Declaration for each article or article part in a complex object. If no SVHC are used or present in any article parts in a concentration of more than or equal to 0.1%, one declaration is sufficient.

Note that packaging is considered an article itself.
